Outdoor (Ring 1) classes 20-52 begin at 8:00am Indoor (Ring 2) classes 1-19 begin at 8:30am

## Rules:

- 1.) Horse and rider combinations showing walk trot or cross rails may not cross-enter into any other over fences division on the same show day. Rider may show a different horse in another division.
- 2.) Youth is for riders under 18 as of January 1, 2026.
- 3.) Riders or their parent/guardian must sign risk form before showing (one time per season).
- 4.) Riders must show in a proper ASTM/SEI approved helmet.
- 5.) Judge's decisions are final.
- 6.) Good sportsmanship is expected.
- 7.) Management reserves the right to dismiss any horse and rider combination for any reason at any time. Safety is of utmost importance.

## Stalls:

- 1) Stalls are very limited in numbers, please consider showing from your trailer if at all possible.
- 2) The opportunity group for each show will have first right to reserve stalls for that day as the work is done on Friday and Saturday.
- 3) Stall reservations will be accepted 2 weeks prior to the show date.

- 4) No full season reservations will be accepted in 2026, this has led to too many people missing out.
- 5) Some stalls will be "pens" built with pipe gating. Those moving in on Friday will have first dibs on actual permanent or temporary horse stalls.
- 6) Anyone not cleaning a stall at the end of the day will forfeit deposit and not be allowed to reserve a stall for future shows.
- 7) There will be a waitlist. If you have reserved a stall and cannot attend the show, please notify management via text (585) 721-3205 ASAP.

## Camping:

- 1) Camping is available (Friday night prior to show) with electric only. Water tanks can be filled upon arrival. Cost is \$25. NO ARRIVAL BEFORE 1PM ON FRIDAY.
